

## Advocare CEO receives honorary degree

Dr. John M. Tedeschi, chairman of the board and chief executive officer of South Jersey's Advocare, a primary care provider/healthcare management company, received an honorary degree from Rosemont College on May 14.

Rosemont College will bestow a honorary degree to Tedeschi for his dedication to serving his community and the region's youth throughout his distinguished career.

Nationally recognized for his work in the field of pediatric medicine, Tedeschi has been recognized by "top" lists and publications including Best Doctors in America, the 2008 Guide to America's Top Pediatricians, and multiple listings in the National Register's Who's Who in Executives and Professionals to "Top Doc" profiles in regional and local magazines.

He attended Villanova University and Creighton University School of Medicine. In 2010, Tedeschi was appointed to the Cooper Health System Board of Trustees, and has remained instrumental in developing the curriculum for the Cooper Medical School of Rowan University — set to open in 2012.

His exemplary career over four decades in pediatric medicine was also recognized in October 2009 with the launch of The John M. Tedeschi Pediatric Institute at Virtua, a \$25 million programmatic and philanthropic initiative designed to improve children's health at the local, state, and national levels.
