Tedeschi, M.D., Chairman and CEO of Continuum Health Alliance, LLC, and Advocate, LLC will receive a lifetime achievement award at the upcoming Philadelphia Business Journal Healthcare Innovation Awards breakfast on Tuesday, November 8th, at the Philadelphia Downtown Marriott Hotel.
